

## What is a Regularly Scheduled Series or RSS

- ◆ Regularly scheduled series is a live activity planned as a series with multiple, ongoing sessions, offered weekly, monthly or quarterly
- ◆ Occurs on a regular, recurring schedule
- ◆ Maximum number of sessions - 52
- ◆ Each format has its own series. The types of formats are:
  - Grand Rounds
  - M&M Conferences
  - Case Conference
  - Tumor Boards
  - Journal Club
  - Quality Conference
  - Sims Conference
- ◆ Designed for a relatively consistent learner group of physicians, nurses, PAs, Pharmacists, and other professional staff of the institution
- ◆ Scientifically based, accurate, current and objectively presented

- Physicians
- Nurses
- Physician assistants
- Pharmacists

### An RSS can Provide Additional Designation for

- PSRM
- Opioid
- Maintenance of Certification (MOC) for: ABIM, ABPath, AbSurg
