Program Overview & Target Audience

Penn Medicine Cutting Edge Rheumatology 2020: Inflammatory Arthritis is a half-day course featuring internationally recognized experts who will provide lectures on the state-of-the-art for evaluating and treating inflammatory arthritis, specifically rheumatoid arthritis, axial spondyloarthritis, and psoriatic arthritis (including psoriasis). Speakers will discuss advances in outcome measurement and management, providing knowledge that can be incorporated into clinical practice. The latest research advances and novel therapies will be highlighted. The panel discussions will address important clinical conundrums and weigh the risks and benefits of management choices.

Penn Medicine Cutting Edge Rheumatology 2020: Inflammatory Arthritis is designed to meet the educational needs of rheumatologists and other physicians specializing in, or with an interest in, the evaluation and management of various forms of inflammatory arthritis.

Learning Objectives

At the conclusion of this educational activity, the participant should be better able to:

- Review current pharmacotherapies and treatment algorithms for rheumatoid arthritis, psoriatic arthritis and axial spondyloarthritis
- Appropriately use laboratory and non-invasive imaging modalities for diagnosis and management of inflammatory arthritis
- Discuss challenging treatment scenarios in inflammatory arthritis
- Discuss the diagnosis and treatment of non-radiographic axial spondyloarthritis
- Review the current state of research into new therapies for inflammatory arthritis and how such work applies to the routine care of patients with inflammatory arthritis

Registration Fees
