PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The program will draw upon recent clinical advances and guidelines, as well as the presenters' clinical experience, to provide a practical approach to diagnosis and management of patients with interstitial lung disease (ILD). The format will be primarily case-based discussions, with presentation of evidence where it helps inform management decisions. The participant will come away from the conference with increased confidence in diagnosing and managing patients with a variety of ILDs.



TARGET AUDIENCE

This conference is designed to engage pulmonologists, advance practice providers, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, pharmacists, nurses, fellows, residents and students.

- Describe the medical treatment of patients with ILD, including therapy initiation, monitoring, modification
- Discuss options for patients with more advanced ILD, including lung transplantation and palliative care
